COMPUTER LAB BOOKING GOES COMPLETELY ON-LINE

In an effort to improve efficiency and keep the lines of communication open, the booking for all four computer labs will go exclusively online effective Tuesday, October 1st. No need to panic! This is a change for the better.

The benefit is that all staff members will be able to access and see current and future lab use schedules no matter where you are in the building. That means no more running down to the LMC to sign-up and no having to call to see if your desired time is open.

First, you will view the calendars in Outlook. Once you verify your desired lab and time are available, you will type in your name and

the hours you'd like to reserve. A notification of your request will immediately be sent to Natalie in the LMC who will then approve it. No worries, no one else can steal your spot while you await approval.

The initial calendar set up is a two step process: First, you must be using the client version of Outlook on your school computer and

second, you must set up your calendar so that you have access to all lab schedules. [Instructions for both steps were emailed with this newsletter and are available in the LMC.](#)

Understandably, this is a time of transition and it will take awhile for everyone to get the hang of the new system. I can assure you that this change is taking place so that our

team can truly work smarter, not harder. I am readily available to help all of you set up your computers and to answer any questions you may have with the booking process.

As a final note, effective Oct 1st, the online calendars will supersede all paper calendars kept either inside or outside of the LMC.

SOMETHING TO CONSIDER

Students are sent down to the LMC throughout the day to continue working on a computer assignment or to print a recent document.

Often times, when a class has reserved the LMC computer lab, there are no computers available for the walk-in students that come down.

Because the LMC is the only monitored computer lab in the school, I will ask that all

teachers consider first booking one of the three other computer labs: either the 1st floor, 2nd floor, or 3rd floor labs. This will ensure that your students have computers and supervision and that the LMC remains available for those walk-in students that need access to computers.
